## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- A diploma or bachelor's degree related to piano (performance or music education). Third- and fourth-year university students majoring in music will be considered. Candidates without these educational credentials may be considered if they have relevant performance experience.
- The ability to teach both beginner and early intermediate piano (RCM level 5)
- A positive and encouraging approach to teaching
- One year of teaching experience
- The ability to be reliable, punctual and organized
- The ability to use Dropbox, Google Drive and Zoom
- The candidate must be able to work as part of a team
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Proficiency in Word and Excel
- Willingness to learn and adapt as needed
